

VEHICLE PREPARATION

GENERAL

- 2. Shift vehicle into PARK.
- 3. Turn key to OFF position and remove key.

1. Park vehicle on a flat surface.

ACCESSORY INSTALLATION


1. Attach ratchet (A) to inside of cover using hook and loop fastener.

IMPORTANT


If ratchet is loose it may damage vehicle during cover installation.



- 2. Put cover on vehicle. Make sure end of cover with ratchet is positioned at rear of vehicle.
- 3. Connect buckle (B) at front of vehicle.




4. Route strap through loop ① at rear of vehicle. Route end of strap ② through ratchet ④ and pull until snug.



5. Pull cover down over vehicle as far as possible.



- 6. Tighten strap around vehicle using ratchet. Do not overtighten.
- 7. Route center strap under machine and attach using buckle (E). Pull end of strap to tighten cover.



OPERATION

- Make sure cover is tight before trailering vehicle. A loose cover may flap and cause damage to vehicle.
- Do not trailer covered vehicle in excess of speed limit.
- Make sure covered vehicle is always trailered facing forward. Cover is not designed to be used with vehicle facing rearward.
