





INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


1. Insert the rubber block (13) in the main body (10), with the help of a screwdriver push the nipple into the hole.




2. Install three plastic trims (11 and 12) on the main body.




3. Assemble the retainer (8) to the base stand with the M8 bolt (3) and nut (4) as shown.




4. Install the lock & ride (7) onto the base stand by following their included instructions.



5. Attach the main body (10) on the base stand (9) with two M6 screws (1) and two M6 nuts (5). Finger tight only.



6. Assemble the center M6 bolt (2) and the rubber strap (6) as shown. Finger tighten only.



- 7. Install the gun scabbard on the vehicle as desired and put your gun in it.
- 8. Lock your gun boot with the rubber strap.
- 9. Adjust the angle position for your gun and tighten all the bolts and screws. Check for interference between gun boot and vehicle.
