





INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Place vehicle in "PARK". Turn key to "OFF" position and remove from vehicle.
- 2. Remove (rear) seats.
- 3. If vehicle has multi-point harness accessory installed, then perform the following:
 - a. Carefully cut lower panel ② in machined grooves on rear of panel as shown.




b. Cut trim ⑦ into two equal lengths, then install trim to lower panel ② as shown.



4. Snap retainer clips ③ into upper panel ① and lower panel ② as shown. Ensure clips are facing proper direction.




5. Push rubber bumpers ④ into lower edge of lower panel ② as shown.




6. Assemble upper panel (1) to lower panel (2) with four dart clips (5) and four lock clips (6) as shown.

NOTE Additional clips ⁽⁶⁾ ⁽⁶⁾ may be included as spares.



 Center panel in ROPS (A), then snap upper two retainer clips ③ into upper cross bar as shown. Work down, snapping remaining retainer clips into ROPS (A).



8. Reinstall seats.
