





INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn ignition switch to "OFF" position and remove key.
- 2. Place all four P-Clamps ② in the approximate locations shown onto the forward most ROPS tubes making sure they are orientated as shown.



After installing the P-Clamps, place the windshield
into position and line up all mounting holes.
Once lined up insert the mounting hardware as shown. DO NOT TIGHTEN at this time.




4. After installing and BEFORE TIGHTENING the mounting hardware, firmly pull the windshield downward to ensure the rubber gasket (4) comes in contact with the upper dash panel (8).



5. Once windshield is in the proper position, torque mounting fasteners (5) on all four corners of windshield to specification provided.





6. Ensure all tools are accounted for and all steps have been completed.
