#### **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **REMOVE EXISTING TERMINAL BLOCK**

1. Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn ignition switch to "OFF" position and remove key.


#### **WARNING**

Ensure red positive (+) battery terminal is COMPLETELY COVERED by protective boot. Accidental tool contact across both battery terminals will result in high current electrical arc, and may result in battery explosion. Death or serious personal injury may occur.


Black negative (-) cable MUST be disconnected from battery terminal. Failure to disconnect cable may result in electrical arc when installing connections at terminal block. Death or serious personal injury, or damage to vehicle or accessory, may occur.

- 2. Flip up passenger seat bottom and remove underseat storage compartment. Disconnect black negative (-) cable from battery.
- 3. Remove hood.
- 4. Disconnect all accessory harness connectors plugged into existing terminal block.
- Remove nut 


   from terminal block stud identified as "BAT –", then detach chassis ground cable. Retain nut.




6. Slide red boot along **"T-BLOCK (B+)"** battery cable, remove nut **(B)** from terminal block stud identified as **"BAT +"**, then detach battery cable. Retain nut.



7. Detach harness connector © from terminal block connector identified as "ACC".




8. Remove four screws (D), then remove terminal block. Retain screws. Terminal block will not be reused.




#### **INSTALL NEW TERMINAL BLOCK**


1. Install new terminal block ① to vehicle using four retained screws <sup>①</sup>.




2. Join harness connector C to terminal block connector identified as "ACC".



 Install "T-BLOCK (B+)" battery cable to terminal block stud identified as "BAT +", then reinstall nut B. Torque nut to specification, then reposition red boot over stud.



4. Install chassis ground cable to terminal block stud identified as "**BAT** –", then reinstall nut (A). Torque nut to specification.



5. Reconnect accessory harness connectors to new terminal block ①.

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- 6. Reconnect black negative (-) cable to battery, then reinstall under-seat storage compartment.
- 7. Reinstall hood.
