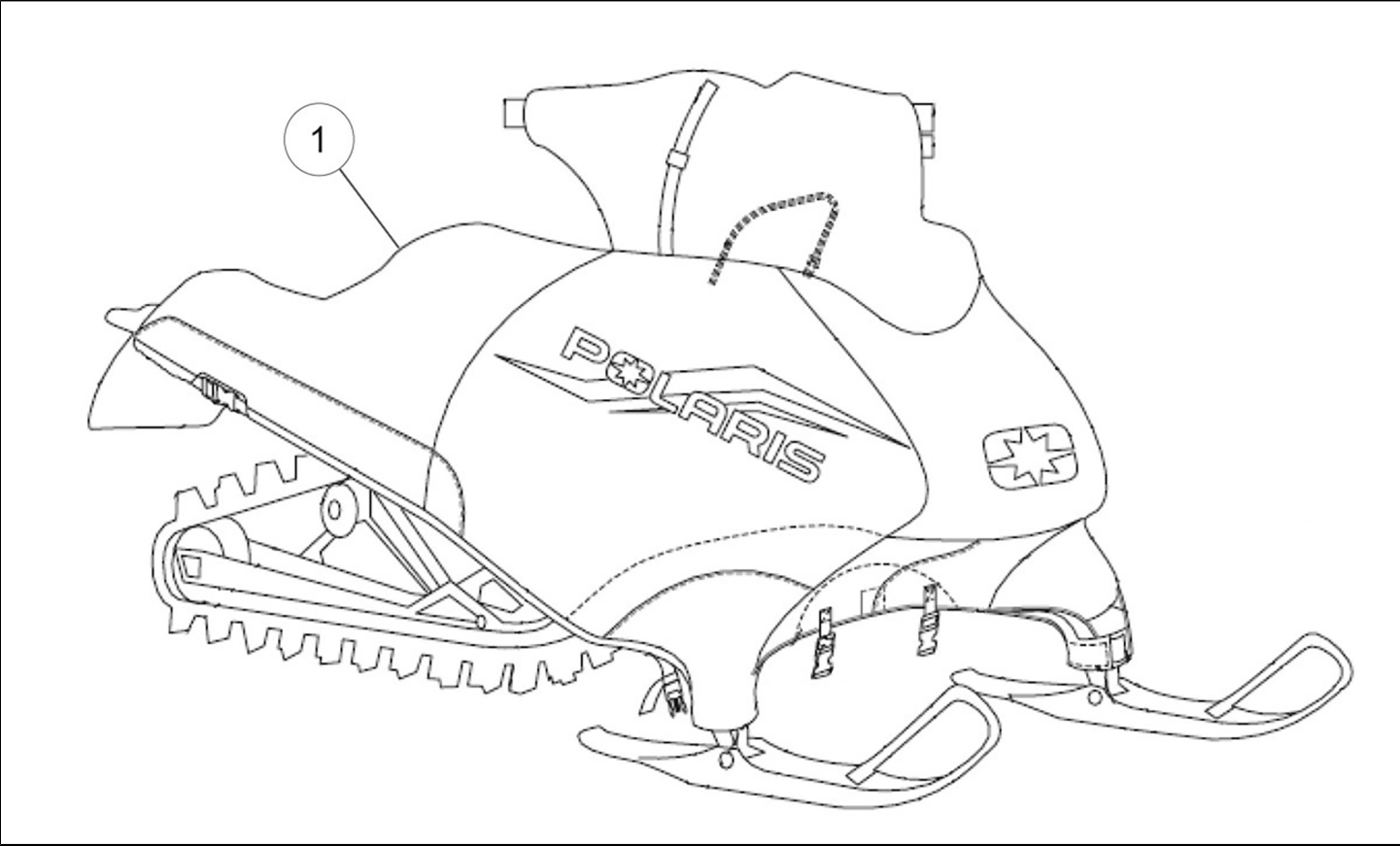

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

VEHICLE PREPARATION

GENERAL

1. Park vehicle on a flat surface.
2. Push engine stop switch to OFF position.
3. Turn key to OFF position and remove key.

ACCESSORY INSTALLATION

NOTICE

RMK installation shown, other models similar.

1. Put the cover over the top of the snowmobile, fitting it over the windshield and around the handlebars.



2. Put cover over front of snowmobile. Line up seam with the front bumper.

TIP

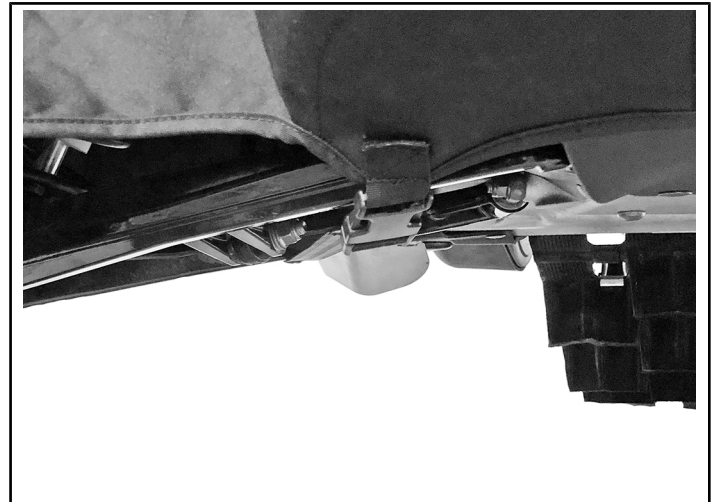
Use the Polaris® logo to help locate the cover on the snowmobile.



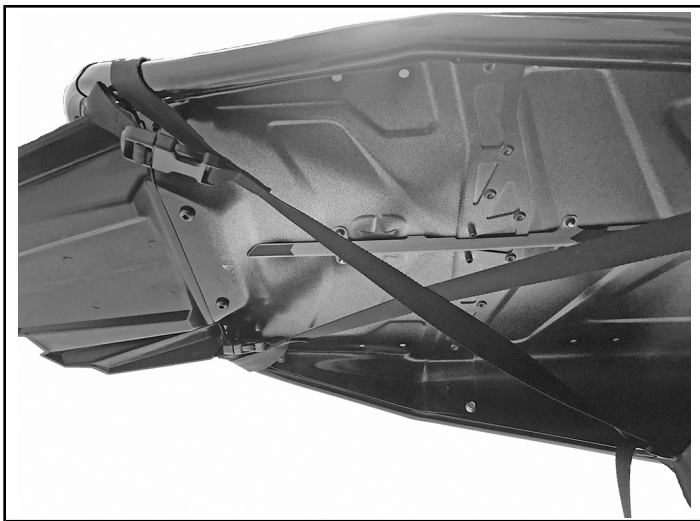
3. Put hook and loop fastener around the suspension spindles, just above the ski.



4. Connect the straps under the lower suspension arms.



5. Connect the right rear strap to the left corner of the rear bumper. Then connect the left rear strap to the right corner of the rear bumper. The straps will cross under the tunnel.



6. Pull the straps tight.



7. Make sure the cover is placed evenly on the snowmobile. Adjust windshield straps as needed.
