
VEHICLE PREPARATION

GENERAL

- 1. Park vehicle on a flat surface.
- 2. Shift vehicle into PARK.
- 3. Turn key to OFF position and remove key.

DASHBOARD STORAGE REMOVAL


1. Open center dashboard storage compartment.



2. Remove storage compartment from dashboard.

TIP

If removing storage compartment is difficult, carefully use tool to pry storage compartment upwards where marked "LIFT HERE."




DASHBOARD TOP REMOVAL


1. Carefully pull up to remove left, center, and right dashboard trim pieces.

TIP

Release steering tilt lock for improved access.




Open glove box lid. Remove and keep four dashboard fasteners around glove box opening.




3. Remove and keep three front dashboard fasteners around glove box opening.


Make note of different screw sizes in steps 2 and 3.




4. Tilt steering wheel down. Remove and keep four dashboard fasteners from dashboard surrounding steering wheel.




5. Remove and keep two dashboard fasteners from front of vehicle.




6. Remove and keep two push-pin rivets from front side hood panels.



7. Carefully lift edge of left front hood panel to release tab from dashboard top as shown.




8. Carefully lift edge of right front hood panel to release tab from dashboard top as shown.



9. Carefully keep panels up-and-away from tabs and remove dashboard top by tilting rear section up and pulling out toward rear.

TIP Two people are recommended to complete this step.




MAIN WINDSHIELD WIPER HARNESS

1. Place main wiper harness ② within accessory mounting panel and join the following connectors:




2. Route bundle of four connectors (24A, 24B, 24C, and 24D) to right A-pillar. Secure to vehicle with edge clip 24E.




3. Route washer pump connector 24K through firewall grommet.




4. Remove switch blank from lower dash panel.



5. Route switch connector 24G below accessory mounting panel to switch opening and connect to switch @.




6. Push switch ② into lower dash panel until tabs snap into place. Note switch orientation shown in graphic.




ROPS WINDSHIELD WIPER HARNESS


1. Slide right rubber boot up ROPS to reveal lower brace of A-pillar.




2. Feed fish tape (or equivalent) into opening of lower brace and up A-pillar, toward top cross-beam.




3. Locate fish tape and pull from round opening, as shown.



4. Tape ROPS harness **(4)** to fish tape and pull harness through holes and out opening in lower brace.




5. Secure ROPS harness to vehicle with edge clip ②).




6. Join main wiper harness 4 to ROPS harness 3.

WASHER FLUID BOTTLE INSTALLATION


1. Identify indentation in hood liner.




2. With a utility knife, carefully cut around edges of indentation.


Control tool depth. Electrical harness and other components are located directly below cut lines.



3. Install four U-clip nuts (6) onto bottle mounting bracket (7).




4. Install one U-clip nut 16 onto vehicle chassis.



5. Install bottle mounting bracket ① onto firewall with two fasteners ⑧.


Use care to not over-torque fasteners.




6. Install front of bottle mounting bracket ① onto chassis with one fastener ② and screw ⑤.

IMPORTANT

Use care to not over-torque fasteners.



7. Join washer pump connector 24K to washer pump. Slide wiper hose ⁽⁹⁾ onto washer pump until it is tightly secured.




8. Place bottle assembly into mounting bracket and secure with five fasteners (5).

NOTICE

Ensure wiper hose and harness are clear of all moving vehicle parts. Use cable ties 20, as needed.

Use care to not over-torque fasteners.




DASHBOARD TOP INSTALLATION


1. Carefully lift panels up-and-away from tabs and install dashboard top into place by tilting rear section up and installing front section first, then lower rear section into place.

TIP

Two people are recommended to complete this step.




2. Make sure tabs on panels are aligned in slots on dashboard top. (Passenger-side panel shown; driver-side panel similar.)




3. Make sure both rubber boots are properly seated around hood panels. Only upper lip should be visible, as shown with inset.



Push up on inside of fender to ease installation.




4. Reinstall two retained front dashboard fasteners into front edge of top dashboard.






5. Install hood panels to vehicle with two retained push-pin rivets



6. Tilt steering wheel down. Install four retained screws through dashboard top and torque to specification.


WINDSHIELD WIPER MOTOR INSTALLATION

1. Remove and discard two plugs from top of windshield.



2. Slide the following hardware onto wiper arm shaft and arm stopper shaft.







4. Install cap ® over nut on arm stopper shaft. Install wiper arm cap ④ onto wiper arm shaft.





6. Lift wiper arm cap to reveal mounting bracket.




7. Place wiper arm onto wiper arm shaft in a position that will allow wiper blade to fully clean windshield.



9. Join wiper motor to ROPS harness connector 25F.


POWERING WINDSHIELD WIPER ON/OFF

Vehicle battery must be turned on for windshield wiper to function.




NOZZLE ADJUSTMENT

FILLING WASHER FLUID RESERVOIR

Remove center hood panel to access washer fluid reservoir. Fill reservoir to line marked "Full." Never fill reservoir past "Full" line.
