

VEHICLE PREPARATION

GENERAL

- 1. Park vehicle on a flat surface.
- 2. Shift vehicle into PARK.
- 3. Turn key to OFF position and remove key.

NOTICE

Installation shows 72" plow blade. Number of wear bar fasteners will vary depending on length of plow blade.




Place plow carriage on kick stand before servicing plow blade.


UHMW wear bar should be at room temperature before installation.


1. Remove and discard existing wear bar and hardware.






2. Put wear bar ④ on plow. Align upper holes on wear bar ④ with mounting holes on plow.







3. Make sure wear indicator arrows at center of wear bar are pointing down.



4. Loosely attach wear bar ④ to plow blade using screws ②, washers ① and nuts ③. Install middle two fasteners first and continue to ends of wear bar.

DO NOT torque fasteners at this time.






5. Torque nuts ③ to specification.


TORQUE Nuts ③: 12 ft-lbs (16 N·m)

OPERATION

• When wear bar use reaches "Maximum Wear Indicator" plug (A), the wear bar can be removed and flipped to use the opposite edge.







• When second wear indicator plug is reached after flipping wear bar, replace the wear bar.
