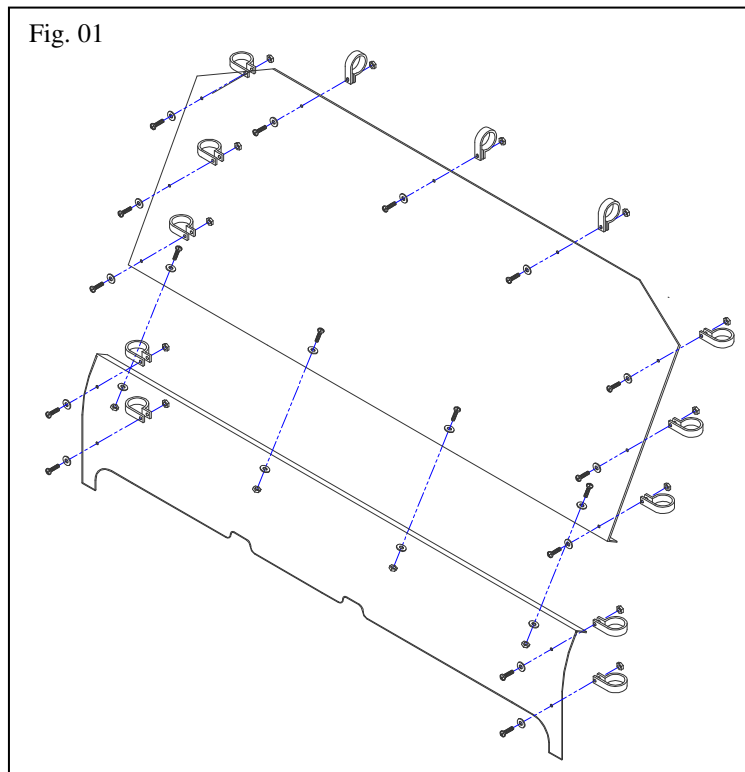

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Assemble Windshield:** Refer to figure one. Position upper and lower windshields together. Assemble them together using four screws, eight flat washers, and flange nuts as shown.
NOTE: Torque fasteners to 25 in-lbs. – do not over tighten.
- For ease of assembly the trim has been applied to the upper windshield, once you assemble the lower to the upper you must finish by pressing the trim from the upper onto the lower shield and trim to length.
- Install windshield on machine:** Refer to figure one again.



Position windshield onto machine. Place the thirteen clamps around the perimeter of the cab frame. Now install the windshield to the clamps using the remaining 13 screws, fender washers, and flange nuts as shown.
NOTE: Torque fasteners to 25 in-lbs. – do not over tighten.

Cleaning Instructions:

- Use a high pressure water supply to rinse the large dirt particles from the windshield.
- Once the majority of dirt is removed, use warm soapy water and a cotton terry cloth to wash all windshield components.
- Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry.
- Use a premium plastic cleaner/polish such as *Plexus*® or *Novus*® to properly clean the viewing area of the windshield. (Never use paper towels, only use clean cotton terry cloths.)
